§ 155.01 ADOPTION OF PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE BY REFERENCE.

That a certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the city, being marked and designated as "The BOCA National Property Maintenance Code, Fourth Edition, 1993" as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., as modified by the City Council of the city be and is hereby adopted as the Property Maintenance Code of the city for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said modified BOCA National Property Maintenance Code are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this chapter. § 155.02 ADDITIONS, INSERTIONS AND CHANGES BY THE BUILDING OFFICIALS AND CODE ADMINISTRATORS INTERNATIONAL, INC.

That the BOCA National Property Maintenance Code is amended and revised in the following respects:

Section PM-101.1 (page 1, second line). Insert: City of Bardstown.

Section PM-106.2. Replace existing language with the following:

Any person found guilty of a violation of any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a Class B misdemeanor. Violators of this chapter may be issued a citation by the officer in charge of enforcement. In addition or in the alternative, any person determined to be in violation of this chapter may be assessed civil penalties or fines, those fines assessed through the Code Enforcement Board process as provided in §§ 34.20 through 34.33 in the amount of no less than \$50 nor more than \$150 for the first offense, no less than \$75 nor more than \$200 for the second offense and no less than \$100 nor more than \$250 for any subsequent offense.
